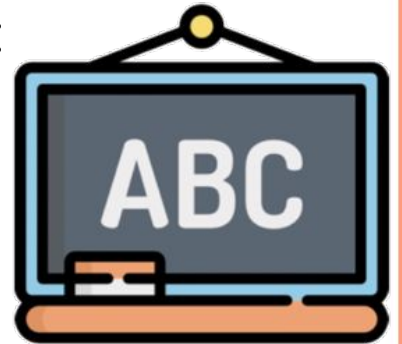

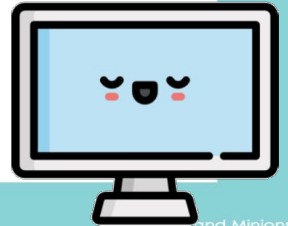


chromebook care
