COVID-19 Health Screening



Symptom screening for staff and students is no longer required for schools in Los Angeles County. If staff and /or families wish to continue to input their information in the health screening app on ParentSquare, they may continue to do so. District staff will not be monitoring this system moving forward. I want to thank each of you for your commitment to enter the data for the last 2 years. We know that it has taken a lot of time for you to do this. I want to extend an appreciation to our office staff and Principals who continued to monitor the data and support families when needed. 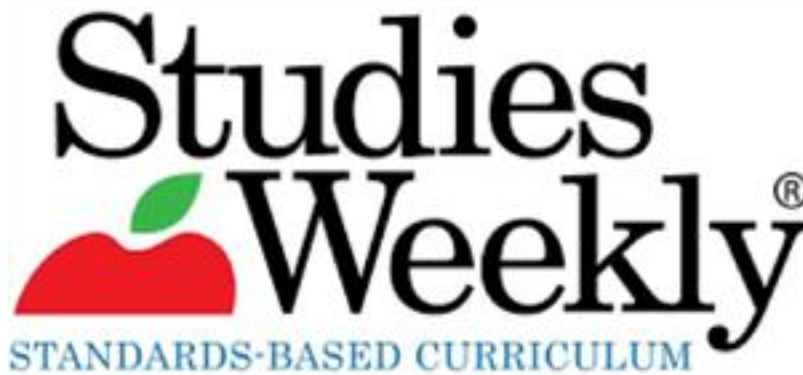

Please know, even though your insurance information is requested, we were informed that you will not have any co-pay or any other type of payment requested. If you have insurance, your insurance will be billed, and any insurance reimbursement is covered through the CARES act. If you have any questions regarding this Pop-Up COVID-19 Testing Clinic, please call 310-285-3331. You will be notified of the results through the email that you use when you register. The Clinic will be offering a Rapid Antigen Test and a PCR Test for each person that they test.



Parents received the Annual Parent/Guardian Notification Handbook at the beginning of the school year and/or during the first week that their child was enrolled. We are providing an updated copy to all families in our schools which provides your rights as a parent and the instructional programs in the District. During the 2019-2020 and 2021-2022 school year, our students have been working with Studies Weekly Curriculum as a supplement to our Social Studies program.

The Social Studies Curriculum Committee, comprised of teachers and administrators, has recommended that the District formally adopt Studies Weekly as the District's new Social Studies program for the 2022-2023 school year. As part of the adoption process, parents are provided access to the curriculum for review. Since your child is already using this curriculum now, you have access to review it. The Educational Services Department will also be sending out a separate ParentSquare email to provide you access to the materials for viewing online.
