# Class Assignments: In-Person and Scholars@Home Online Independent Study Program

Your child's class assignment for the 22/23 school year will be available starting at 10:00 AM on Monday, August 8th through your Aeries Parent Portal. Please remember that there will NOT be any class lists posted at school sites. If you are unable to access the Aeries Parent Portal, please contact your school who will be available to assist you after August 8th or contact the District Office at 661-252-5131 or email pupilservices@sssd.k12.ca.us. Please note, your child's class list will only be visible in the Aeries Parent Portal if you have completed the Data Confirmation. The Data Confirmation is your review of the beginning of the year documents that require parent/guardian signatures. The Data Confirmation will be available to complete in Aeries Parent Portal starting on July 6th. A ParentSquare email will be sent to you on July 6th to remind you to check your Aeries Parent Portal.



### Scholars@Home Online Independent Study Program

Please know that if you are planning on enrolling your child in the Scholars@Home Independent Study Online Program for the 22/23 school year, you will need to complete an Intra-District Transfer Form. Once the form is completed, please return the form to your nearest school's front office, District Office, or email it to pupilservices@sssd.k12.ca.us. If your child is currently enrolled in the Scholars@Home Independent Study Program and now wish to have your child attend in-person instruction for the 22/23 school year, please contact the Pupil Services Department at 661-252-5131 or email at pupilservices@sssd.k12.ca.us.

If your child was enrolled in Scholars@Home and you want your child to continue in the Program for the 22/23 school year, you do not need to complete any forms. Your child will continue in the Program for the 22/23 school year.

Please also remember that if your child has an IEP, and you would like him/her to be enrolled in the Scholars@Home Online Independent Study program, you will need to request an IEP meeting from your child's school principal. If the IEP team determines that your child's IEP can be implemented with your child enrolled in the Scholars@Home program, you will need to also file a transfer request. #### **Bus Transportation Applications for 2022-2023 School Year**

The Sulphur Springs Union School District is able to provide bus transportation to and from school for a limited number of students. Students are placed on bus routes in the order in which their applications are received until the routes are full. Turning in your application does not guarantee your child a seat on their selected bus route. Students who are not placed on routes will be placed on a waitlist and added to bus routes if and when space becomes available.

Transportation is available for Canyon Springs, Fair Oaks Ranch, Leona Cox, Mint Canyon, Mitchell, Pinetree, Sulphur Springs, and Valley View Community Schools. Transportation is not provided to Golden Oak Community School.

Transportation applications for the 2022-2023 school year will be accepted from June 3 to July 29, 2022. Transportation <u>applications</u> are available on the District <u>website</u> or at the Transportation Office, which is located at: 27000 Weyerhaeuser Way, Santa Clarita, 91351. It is important to remember that any child that is riding a school bus, must have an application on file **prior to boarding**.

Again, all applications must be mailed, emailed at <a href="maileotration@sssd.k12.ca.us">transportation@sssd.k12.ca.us</a> or submitted to the Sulphur Springs Union School District Office or the Transportation Office before July 29, 2022. Applications received after July 29<sup>th</sup> will be placed on a waitlist and transportation cannot be guaranteed at the start of the school year.
