Bus Transportation Applications for 2022-2023 School Year

The Sulphur Springs Union School District is able to provide bus transportation to and from school for a limited number of students. Students are placed on bus routes in the order in which their applications are received until the routes are full. Turning in your application does not guarantee your child a seat on their selected bus route. Students who are not placed on routes will be placed on a waitlist and added to bus routes if and when space becomes available.

Transportation is available for Canyon Springs, Fair Oaks Ranch, Leona Cox, Mint Canyon, Mitchell, Pinetree, Sulphur Springs, and Valley View Community Schools.

Transportation applications for the 2022-2023 school year will be accepted from June 3 to July 29, 2022. Transportation <u>applications</u> are available on the District <u>website</u> or from the transportation office, which is located at: 27000 Weyerhaeuser Way, Santa Clarita. It is important to remember that any child that is riding a school bus, must have an application on file **prior to boarding**.

All applications must be mailed and/or submitted to the Sulphur Springs Union School District office or the transportation office **before July 29, 2022**. The deadline for bus pass applications is <u>July 29, 2022</u>. Applications received after the deadline will be placed on a waitlist and transportation cannot be guaranteed at the start of the school year.


