
Friday Update, January 27, 2023

Assembly Bill 367: Menstrual Products

Existing law requires a "public school maintaining any combination of classes from **grade 6 to grade 12**, inclusive, that meets a 40% pupil poverty threshold specified in federal law, to stock 50% of the school's restrooms with feminine hygiene products, and prohibits a public school from charging for any menstrual products provided to pupils."

In addition, Assembly Bill 367 requires school districts "to stock the school's restrooms with an adequate supply of free menstrual products, as defined, available and accessible, free of cost, in all women's restrooms and all-gender restrooms, and <u>in at least one men's restroom</u>, at all times, and to post a designated notice, on or before the start of the 2022–23 school year, as prescribed."
