

Earthquake 9 Miles from Thousand Oaks

Families, today at 1:47 PM there was an earthquake 9 miles from Thousand Oaks. Many of our staff did not feel it, since it was not centered in Santa Clarita. Please know that all schools have an alert system in place called CrisisGo where they can start an earthquake drill or actual evacuation if necessary. Some of our schools conducted a drill today following the earthquake and practiced. All schools do conduct monthly drills using the CrisisGo System. Thank you.
