- Online: Go to www.sssd.k12.ca.us
- Required Information:
 - Birth certificate or passport verifying date of birth
 - Immunizations (Proof of MMR (including proof of second MMR), Polio, D.P.T., Hepatitis B, and Varicella (Chicken Pox)
 - Two forms of verification of residency (Drivers license, property tax payment receipt, rental property contract, lease or payment receipt, utility service, statement or payment receipt, correspondence from a government agency, hotel/motel receipts, mortgage bill and escrow document)

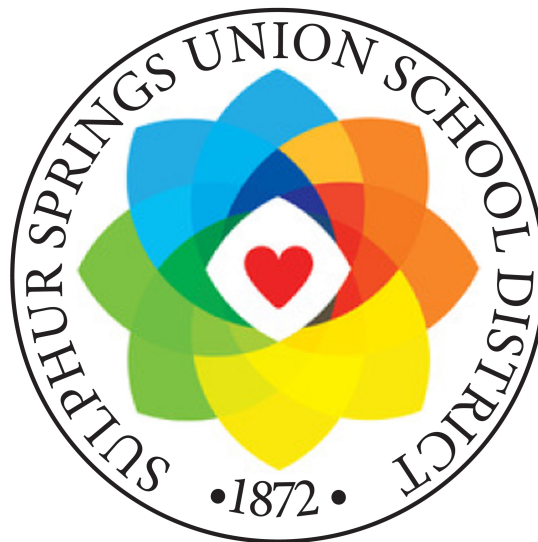
For families that may want to have their child attend another school in the Sulphur Springs Union School District and not their Home School, please see the information about **Intra-District School Transfers**.



- If your home school is within the Sulphur Springs Union School District, please contact your home school and request paperwork to go to another one of our schools. The assigned school site will send the paperwork to Pupil Services at the SSUSD District office.
- If your home school is in another school district, first start at your home district's main office and request a transfer to our district. This paperwork needs to be turned in to the Pupil Services Department at the SSUSD District office.
- Families interested in the [Scholars@Home](#) Program will need to complete a transfer form.
- **All transfers will be reviewed after March 15th**

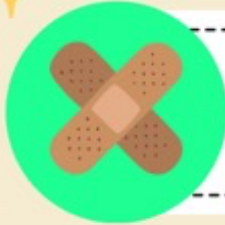
