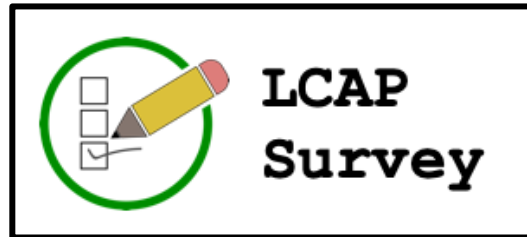


Friday Update, March 1, 2024
