Good evening, Sulphur Springs Families and staff, this is Dr. Catherine Kawaguchi, your Superintendent with your Friday update, August 16, 2024.



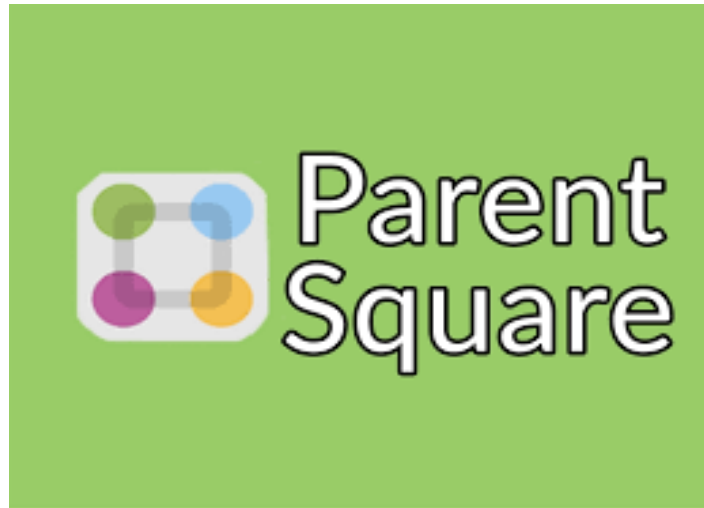

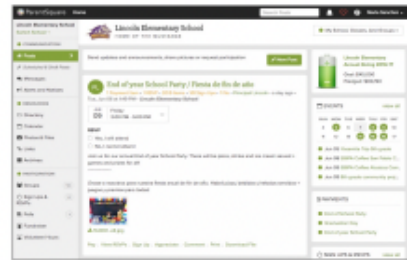

**Reminder**  
**Lunch Applications NOT Required!**

We are excited to inform you that all of our schools qualify as Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) Schools for the 2024-2025 school year. This means that all schools will continue to provide free meals ([breakfast and lunch](#)) for all students at all nine school sites with additional support from the Federal Government.

For families, this means that we are no longer collecting lunch applications from families. Instead, **we encourage all families to complete the Alternative Income Form in their data confirmation.** Your completed form greatly supports funding for our District's educational and social/emotional programs.

For families that wish to have their child enrolled in the District's [free](#) After School Program, RISE or Sunshine Day Camp, it is required that the Alternative Income Form is completed.
