#### Class Assignments: In-Person and Scholars@Home Online Independent Study Program

Your child's class assignment for the 24/25 school year will be available starting at **10:00 AM on Monday, August 12th** through your <u>Aeries Parent Portal</u>. Please remember that there will <u>NOT</u> be any class lists posted at school sites.

Please note: your child's class list will only be visible in the <u>Aeries Parent Portal</u> if you have completed the <u>Data Confirmation</u>. The Data Confirmation is your review of the beginning of the year documents, for example: *emergency card, photo authorization, student technology use agreement*, that require parent/guardian signatures. The Data Confirmation is available to be completed in Aeries Parent Portal at this time. If you need assistance with accessing your child's Aeries Parent Portal, please contact your child's school office. ## Lunch Applications <u>NOT</u> Required for <u>ALL</u> Students!!

We are excited to inform you that all of our schools qualify as Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) Schools for the 2024-2025 school year. This means that <u>all schools will continue to provide free meals (breakfast and lunch) for all students</u> at all nine school sites with additional support from the Federal Government.

For families, this means that we are <u>no longer</u> collecting lunch applications from families. Instead, **we encourage all families to complete the Alternative Income Form in their data confirmation.** Your completed form <u>greatly supports</u> funding for our District's educational and social/emotional programs.

For families that wish to have their child enrolled in the District's free After School Program, RISE or Sunshine Day Camp, it is <u>required</u> that the Alternative Income Form is completed.



The Sulphur Springs Union School District is proud to offer an after school program through the <u>Expanded Opportunities Program</u> (<u>https://www.cde.ca.gov/ls/ex/elopinfo.asp</u>) at all nine schools. The program is by invitation only. Below you will find answers to the most frequently asked questions:

## Q: How do I enroll my child in ELO-P?

The first step is to complete the data confirmation in the Aeries Parent Portal. The **data confirmation** is available now. Make sure to complete all of the sections of the data confirmation.

If families have completed their data confirmation and are found to be eligible, they will receive an invitation to register.

#### Q: What is the eligibility criteria?

Students are invited if they are English learners, students who qualify for free or reduced-price meals, homeless, and/or foster youth.

# School Bus Transportation Applications for the 2024-2025 School Year


## Bus Applications are still being ACCEPTED!

The Sulphur Springs Union School District is able to provide bus transportation to and from school for a limited number of students. Transportation applications for the <u>2024-2025 school year</u> are <u>being accepted at this time</u>. The Transportation Department will do their best to accommodate students riding the bus that wish to ride. However, please know that turning in your application <u>does not guarantee</u> your child a seat on a bus. Students who are not placed on routes will be placed on a waitlist. Students will be added to bus routes based on eligibility and space.

In order for students to ride the school bus <u>at the start of the school year</u>, your child's bus application <u>MUST</u> be approved prior to boarding the bus</u>. Applications are available online, please click <u>HERE</u> to access the applications. If a parent needs a printed application, please go to the school office and/or the District Office located at 27000 Weyerhaeuser Way. It is important to remember that any child that is riding a school bus, must have an application on file *prior to boarding*.

Important: Until you have received a confirmation from the Transportation Department that your child's application is accepted and approved, your child will not be able to ride the bus. The District's Transportation Safety Plan can be found on the District's <u>website</u>. Buses will have active video monitoring enabled. The use of video monitoring will support the safety of students and drivers and prevent vandalism, and may be used to monitor student behavior.

Every school year, the Sulphur Springs Union School District is required to provide all families a copy of the Annual Notification which is designed to notify parents, guardians, and students of their rights and responsibilities per California Education Code (Section 48982) and District Board Policies (BP) and Administrative Regulations (AR).
