Recognized for making the Educational Results Partnership's 2024 Honor Roll List of California's Top Performing School Districts.

The Educational Results Partnership (ERP) has named Sulphur Springs Union School District as ***Honor Roll District for 2024***.

Districts that are placed on the Honor Roll have outperformed their peers in closing achievement gaps, particularly among higher-poverty and historically disadvantaged student populations.

For the 2024 school year, 168 districts made the California Honor Roll. This is approximately 22 percent of all eligible districts in the state. Results are based on data of student outcomes on the California Assessment of Student Performance and Progress (CAASPP) for the 2024 academic year.

At the Board Meeting on December 18, 2024, Dr. Kawaguchi presented a plaque to our Board of Trustees to show appreciation for their leadership and all of the support that they have provided our District Leaders, Teachers, and support staff in continuing to support all of our students to accelerate student learning in reading, writing and math.
