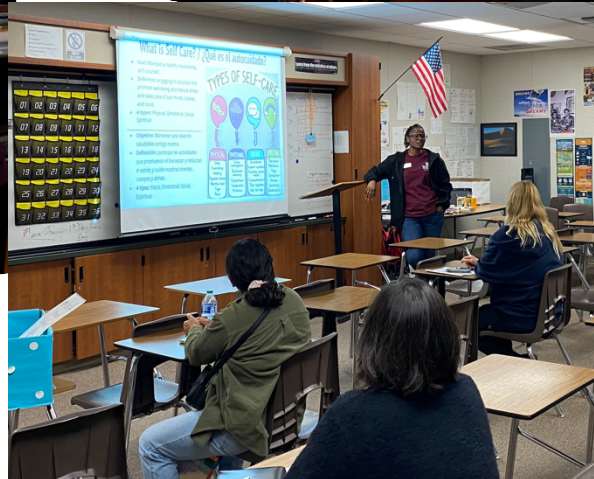
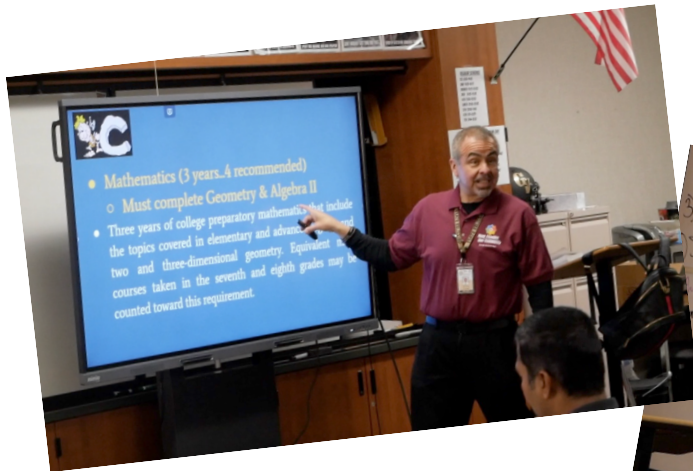

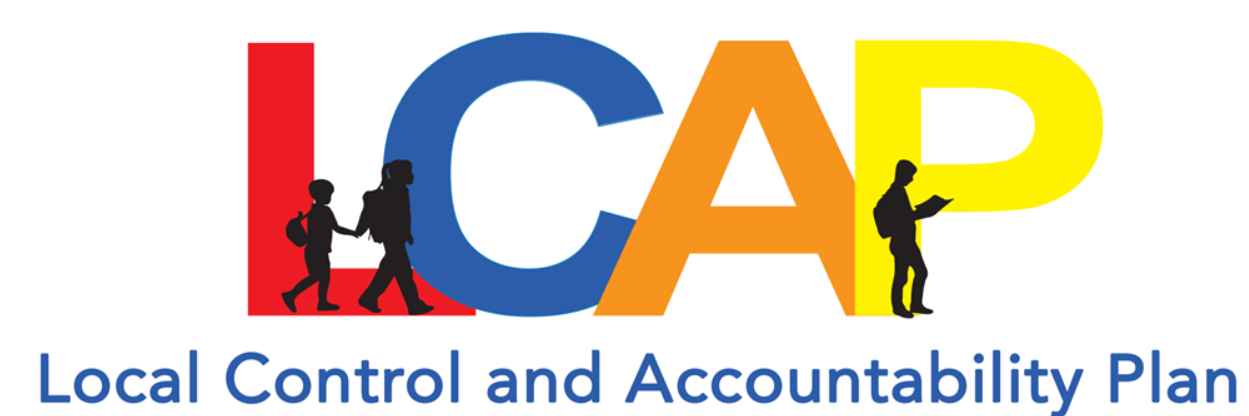

The Local Control and Accountability Plan (LCAP) is a 3-year Plan built on the District's mission, vision, and goals for our students in grades transitional kindergarten to 6th grade. Together, these guide the overall direction for the District's programs and operations.

Educational Partner feedback and input is sought on an annual basis. Parents and District staff partner together to review the progress toward the District's goals. We examine data and gather feedback from students, families, staff, and community. Reviewing the goals and actions guides decisions about actions and services that will be implemented on behalf of students, as well as, the cost for those actions and services.

The LCAP is an important component of the LCFF (Local Control Funding Formula) which is California's approach to funding public schools by streamlining the system and giving school districts more flexibility in how they spend their resources to promote student achievement.
