
Friday Update, July 12, 2024

Every school year, the Sulphur Springs Union School District is required to provide all families a copy of the Annual Notification which is designed to notify parents, guardians, and students of their rights and responsibilities per California Education Code (Section 48982) and District Board Policies (BP) and Administrative Regulations (AR).  - Birth certificate or passport verifying date of birth
 - Immunizations (Proof of MMR (including proof of second MMR), Polio, D.P.T., Hepatitis B, and Varicella (Chicken Pox)
 - Two forms of verification of residency (Drivers license, property tax payment receipt, rental property contract, lease or payment receipt, utility service, statement or payment receipt, correspondence from a government agency, hotel/motel receipts, mortgage bill and escrow document)

The Sulphur Springs Union School District is proud to offer an after school program through the Expanded Opportunities Program
(https://www.cde.ca.gov/ls/ex/elopinfo.asp) at all nine schools. The program is by invitation only. Below you will find answers to the most frequently asked questions:

Q: How do I enroll my child in ELO-P?

The first step is to complete the data confirmation in the Aeries Parent Portal. The **data confirmation** will be available on **July 8**. Make sure to complete all of the sections of the data confirmation.

If families have completed their data confirmation and are found to be eligible, they will receive an invitation to register the week of July 22 via ParentSquare.

Q: What is the eligibility criteria?

Students are invited if they are English learners, students who qualify for free or reduced-price meals, homeless, and/or foster youth.

School Bus Transportation Applications for the

2024-2025 School Year

The Sulphur Springs Union School District is able to provide bus transportation to and from school for a limited number of students. Transportation applications for the 2024-2025 school year are being accepted at this time. The Transportation Department will do their best to accommodate students riding the bus that wish to ride. However, please know that turning in your application does not guarantee your child a seat on a bus. Students who are not placed on routes will be placed on a waitlist. Students will be added to bus routes based on eligibility and space.

In order for students to ride the school bus <u>at the start of the school year</u>, bus applications <u>MUST</u> be submitted no later than <u>July 31, 2024</u>. Applications are available online, please click <u>HERE</u> to access the applications. If a parent needs a printed application, please go to the school office and/or the District Office located at 27000 Weyerhaeuser Way. It is important to remember that any child that is riding a school bus, must have an application on file *prior to boarding*.

Important to remember: All applications must be submitted to the Sulphur Springs Union School District Transportation Department **before July 31, 2024**. Applications received after July 31st will be placed on a waitlist and transportation **cannot be guaranteed** at the start of the school year.

The District's Transportation Safety Plan can be found on the District's website. Buses will have active video monitoring enabled. The use of video monitoring will support the safety of students and drivers and prevent vandalism, and may be used to monitor student behavior.
