This past week has been very exciting seeing children physically back in school for in-person learning. We have welcomed back all of our grades, TK to 6th grade. I want to thank you so much for all that you are doing to ensure that your child is following all of the safety protocols that are in place at each of our nine schools.

As a friendly reminder, all parents need to complete the Health Screening, that is located in ParentSquare, for their child before dropping off in the morning. We know that this is a new step for families to do first thing in the morning, however, it is required before your child enters school. Thank you for making this a priority.

This past week, all 3rd through 6th grade families should have received a salmon colored letter that explains the annual state assessments that students will take in the Spring. It also provides students with a confidential number that they will use when taking these state assessments either at home or at school. Please do not share this information as each student number is unique. Additional information about the annual state assessments will be coming soon.

Upcoming this week, teachers will begin meeting with parents and guardians for parent conferences. This is the time to discuss your child's progress, report card grades, and set goals for the remainder of the school year.

Also, please note by on March 10th, families whose child's instructional program and/or teacher has changed will be notified. All changes will take effect on March 15, 2021.
