Good evening Sulphur Springs Families. This is Dr. Catherine Kawaguchi, your Superintendent with a Friday Update, February 26, 2021.

We have been so excited to welcome back our amazing students for in-person learning. I want to thank you so much for all that you are doing to ensure that your child is following all of the safety protocols that are in place at each of our nine schools.

This past week, we had the opportunity to welcome back our transitional kindergarten students through third grade. On Monday, March 1st, we are looking forward to welcoming back our students who are in a 3/4 combination class, 4th grade, and students in a 4/5 combination class. On Thursday, March 4th, we will welcome back our 5th and 6th graders.

It is important that as our students are returning, we are following the AM / PM set schedules for each school. Please have your student arrive **no sooner** than **15 minutes before the bell rings**. We know that the first day of in-person learning is a very exciting day, however, we are asking parents to drop off their student at the location designated by the Principal. School staff will be on site to take care of your child until dismissal. We thank you in advance for following this important safety protocol.

Please remember that before you bring your child to school, all parents **MUST** complete the ***Health Screening in ParentSquare*** for their child. This must be completed **DAILY**.

When students return to campus, they ***must wear a face covering***. In addition, any adults on campus must wear a face covering.

Please know that students in 3rd through 6th will, from time-to-time, be asked by their teacher to bring their ***District issued device*** back-and-forth from home to school. Students who were not issued a District device for home use will be provided a device at school. ***Please remember that all [personal devices](#) need to stay home and will not be permitted at school.***

As a reminder, our Food Services Program is continuing to provide meals to students five days a week. On Fridays, the Food Services Program is providing additional meals for the weekends. Please remember that students will ***NOT*** be eating breakfast and/or lunch on campus. Students will need to eat prior to arriving to school each day.
