

Friday Update, January 22, 2021

Good evening Sulphur Springs Families. This is Dr. Catherine Kawaguchi, your Superintendent with a Friday Update, January 22, 2021.

At the Special Board meeting on January 19th, I shared information with the Board regarding the District's COVID-19 Safety Plan (CSP) and COVID-19 Prevention Program (CPP). Both the CSP and the CPP are required per the California Department of Public Health and Cal/OSHA by February 1st. If you would like to learn more information about these plans, I encourage you to view the January 19th Board meeting that is posted on our website under 'What's New.' At the January 28th Special Board meeting, I will be recommending the Board to approve the District's CSP and CPP. You will also be able to view this Board meeting live by going to our District website.

The District plans to reopen our schools for small cohorts and continuing our State Preschool programs on February 1st. The students in small cohorts are those students who are receiving services who have special needs. At this time, we are not reopening for grades TK-2 since the California Department of Public Health has required Districts to complete the approval process of the CSP and CPP, and LA County has stated that case rates must be below 25 per 100,000 population in order to reopen.

Please remember that our School Day Café is providing free meals Monday through Friday from 11:30 AM to 1:00 PM, and they are also providing weekend meals. The weekend meals will be provided when families drive up to receive their Friday meals. Please see the attached flyer for more information.
