Dear Sulphur Springs Families,

This is Dr. Catherine Kawaguchi, Superintendent, with your Friday Update, July 10, 2020.

On Wednesday night at the Board meeting, the Board of Trustees approved two Instructional Models for the 2020-21 school year. These Instructional Models are being implemented due to the social distancing requirements that are in place. If you were unable to watch the Board meeting on July 8th, it is posted on the District website under What's New, Fall Planning.

The two Instructional Models are: AM / PM and Learning@Home. Students that attend the AM / PM Instructional Model will go to school 2.5 hours on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday. On Wednesday, the students will be engaged in online learning and working with their classroom teacher. The Learning@Home Instructional Model is a program for families who wish to continue their child's academic learning in the home environment with the ongoing support of a dedicated credentialed teacher.

In order for the District to begin the process for families to select which Instructional Model they prefer for their child for the 2020-21 school year, parents are being asked to complete the [Instructional Model Selection Form](#) found on our website under What's New. All parents will need to make a selection for each child. If a family does not make a selection for their child, your child's placement will automatically default to the AM / PM model.
