

Friday Update June 19, 2020

Dear Sulphur Springs Families,

This is Dr. Catherine Kawaguchi, Superintendent, with your Friday Update, June 19, 2020.

Your child's school Principal sent you a message today about taking a Fall Planning Survey. We are asking all of our families to please take the time to complete this survey so that the District is able to have a better idea as to what families are preferring for their child's instructional program for the 2020-2021 school year. School Districts are still waiting on the Los Angeles County Department of Public Health to issue their directives and guidelines that we need to follow in order to physically reopen our schools in the fall. Once we review the directives and guidelines, then our District will be able to finalize its plan.

Please know that I am aware that many of our families need to know which types of instructional models will be available for the fall so that they can make plans. We apologize for the delay in finalizing our instructional model, however, it is important that we do not finalize our plan until we review the directives and guidelines from LA County Department of Public Health. As you aware, every county is being issued specific directives and guidelines from their Department of Public Health Offices, and this will vary from county to county. This variance is due to the difference in the number of coronavirus cases in each county.

I have been told that LA County Department of Public Health should be sending its final Reopening Plan for schools this coming week. In the meantime, the District will continue to work on the different options that are stated in the survey so that we are prepared to reopen. We feel that it is important to be prepared with multiple Instructional Models, while keeping health and safety as a number one priority, so that we are ready for a safe reopening this fall.

Just a reminder, if families need information about where to locate the sites for the Summer Feeding Program, it is located on the District website. Canyon Springs Community School, located at 19059 Vicci Street, will be providing food to any child between the ages of 1 year and 18 years of age from 9:00AM to 10:00AM Monday through Friday in our District.
