I want to let you know that we have had a great turn out of families coming to the sites to receive free meals, both breakfast and lunch, for students ages 1-18 years of age. As a reminder, families are able to go to any school site to receive the free meals from 11:30AM to 1:00PM. Also, parents are able to get the meals for their children and the children do not need to be present. In addition, you will be receiving the lunch application in your mailbox by early next week. We are asking that you please fill out the lunch application and turn it in at your school office and/or fill out the application online at www.scvschoolnutrition.org. Our schools can receive additional funding to support education in the classrooms based on the number of students who apply for and are approved for free or discounted nutritious meals. We thank you so much for your support so that we can continue to bring supplemental funding to further support our students' educational programs.

Also, I want to let our families know that we are aware that Los Angeles County Department of Public Health is allowing school districts to offer on campus services for small, stable, cohorts of students who need learning support, including children who are English Learners and children that have an Individualized Education Plan. Additional information will be coming regarding having small cohorts of students returning to campus for learning support. At this time, the District is working with staff to support the implementation of bringing students for individualized assessments related to special education and English Learners.
