Q&A	<p>Q: If we have chosen AM/PM and we want to pull them out to go back to Learning @ Home, can we do that?(Rachel)</p> <p>A: Yes. However it's a numbers game, so we would have to make sure there is room in a Learning @ Home classroom. If there is no room, you could always do a Home Study program.</p> <p>Q: What is the update on transportation if we were to go on campus? (Indiana)</p> <p>A: There are new protocols for bus transportation:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● 1 seat per student - then every other row. The number of students that can be transported diminishes.● If that is something you are interested in, make sure you sign-up for it. <p>Q: When it gets closer to the time, would we get correspondence as to what it is going to look like?</p> <p>A: We will send out information about what on-campus protocols will look like.</p> <p>Q: Do you know what the timeframe would be?</p> <p>A: There is a process</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Gauge parent/teacher support2. Apply (each school site applies)3. Application goes to the local level4. Application moves onto state level<ol style="list-style-type: none">a. Schools with largest socio economic disadvantaged students get priority	

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Q: If I want to switch my student to the AM/PM model, will they get to go to Valley View?

A: If you want to go to the AM/PM model, please contact the school to get on the model switch list. As far as VV, it is based on the numbers. If we have room in a VV AM/PM model you will be able to get into one of those classrooms. If VV does NOT have room, you could get placed on campus at another school for the remainder of this year, then you would be returned to VV next year.

*We don't know what room is available until we get all the numbers.

Q: How do the parents notify the school of illness?

A: There is a Health Screen on Parent Square that you will need to fill out every day. If your child presents any of those symptoms, it will instruct you to keep your child home. We don't know what those symptoms ultimately mean.

Q: If we keep our child home sick, will they need a negative test to return? (Rachel)

A: If your child is sick (cold, flu, allergies, etc) and needs to stay home, they need to stay home until their symptoms subside.

If it is Covid, your student would need to get a negative test in addition to going through a confidential protocol that will need to take place prior to their return to campus.

- If there are multiple Covid cases, we would need to follow the protocol to shut down the school.
- If the local levels rise, we may also need to shut down again.

Q: If we keep our child home sick, would they be able to Zoom

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	<p>with their class when they're home? (Rachel)</p> <p>A: There is always asynchronous instruction that they can work on school work at home, and they could participate on synchronous (zoom call) on Wednesdays when all students are home.</p> <p>Q: If my student goes to school and the teacher or a student in class is positive, will the class need to shut down?</p> <p>A: If a positive case, the entire classroom will be notified there was a case.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• The district and the CDC will contact you and ask you to follow a certain protocol.• Anyone with a positive Covid test has to be quarantined and not allowed to return until you have a negative test.
